



# Building & Grounds

#### From Carroll Chewning, co-Chair:

The Storm Water Drainage Upgrade Project has been completed. The purpose of the project was to alleviate water intrusion into the basement during heavy rain events. The existing underground piping carrying water from the gutter downspouts around the sanctuary portion of the building was mostly black corrugated pipe that, in places, was partially collapsed, clogged with grass, undersized, and poorly

sloped. So water backed up next to the foundation wall.

New SDR 35 sewer pipe was installed. The new main line on the west side is 6" diameter and now discharges into the Town's storm water vault instead of at the curb. The new main line on the east side is 4". All branch lines to gutter downspouts are 4". Branch lines were extended to two additional future downspout locations, one on each side of the sanctuary.

A new gently sloped swale was installed on the west side, and a more durable rubber liner was placed on top of it. The existing large river rock that was holding down the old liner was saved and reused to hold down the new liner.

**Using the fancy word** *perichoresis* (from Greek for "around" and "contain") may win you admiring — or strange! — looks. But since the 7<sup>th</sup> century, people have used it as a beautiful image of the Persons of the Holy Trinity containing and permeating one another. A more familiar word, *choreography*, has led to recent understandings of perichoresis as the divine and eternal dance of love.



Picture three dancers' synchronized yet independent movements. Weaving gracefully in and out, each seems to know what the others will do next. They may touch lightly but don't constrain or impede one another. Though distinct individuals, they move so fluidly together that they are, in a sense, one entity.

Even more profound: Jesus invites us into the dance! "If you love me," he says, "you will keep my command-ments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the Spirit of truth. ... I will come to you. ... I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you" (John 14:15-20, ESV). As the actions of Jesus, the Father and the Spirit interweave in Scripture and in the world, may our lives too be drawn into the loving dance.
